Mr. Dort is a member of the Sarasota Soil Conservation District, the Sarasota County Public Hospital Board, the Sister City Association, and is past president of the Sunnyland Council, Boy Scouts of America, of the Players of Sarasota, and the Sarasota Bay Country Club. He is a member of the Sarasota Rotary Club.

Mr. Dort recently became a vice president and co-owner of Hansen Chris-Craft Sales Inc. in Sarasota.
