A new textbook on a specialized area of mathematics written by a New College faculty member has been published by a major textbook firm.

"Inverse Functions," written by Dr. William K. Smith, professor of mathematics at New College, has been published by The Macmillan Company.

Dr. Smith began the book shortly before joining the faculty in 1964 and completed the manuscript while on campus.

He said that it is a supplementary text, dealing with an area of mathematics not usually covered adequately in the study of calculus.

Dr. Smith is the author of several other texts including a standard college mathematics text which he wrote with another mathematician and a specialized text, "Limits and Continuity," which was published in 1964.
