Peter W. Odell, director of physical activities and tutor in Spanish at New College has been appointed to the staff of the Admissions Office at the college.

Odell came to New College last fall to coordinate student activities, primarily in recreation, and also to teach Spanish.

As a member of the admissions staff he will help to recruit new students for New College, beginning with those who will enter as the class of 1970.

A graduate of Williston Academy in Massachusetts, Odell attended Wesleyan University where he was a varsity football and baseball player. After graduation he did further studies at Middlebury College, the University of Madrid, and Southern Methodist University.

From 1962 to 1965 he was a teacher of Spanish, director of athletics and a coach in baseball and football at The Greenhill School in Dallas, Texas.
