A New College student has been notified she won third prize in the Short Poem Division of the Fifteenth Annual Poetry Month Competition.

Glenda Cimino, a third-year student from Atlanta, Ga., received the prize for her poem, "Circle of Death."

She was one of more than 300 entries in the competition sponsored by the Society of Fine Arts for the Tampa Bay area. Competition was open to all Florida residents with no restrictions on theme or style.

Dr. Albert Howard Carter, published poet and Dean of Humanities at Florida Presbyterian College, served as judge.

Miss Cimino will enter the national Mademoiselle Magazine writing contest which closes in January. Last year she won second prize in a literary contest sponsored at New College by the student newspaper, The Catalyst.

As a high school student in Atlanta, she received various awards for her creative writing. She is also a regular contributor to a literary supplement published monthly by the student newspaper.
