A class in life drawing is now available for area artists at the New College Fine Arts Institute on the New College campus.

The class, taught by Mrs. Gail Mead, will be held in the main auditorium of the Fine Arts building.

Classes will be from 1 to 4 p.m. Tuesdays. The fee for the course, which will continue until mid-April, is \$12 per month.

Anyone, from beginners to advanced artists, may participate in the class, according to Mrs. Mead. Since the class will be limited to 30 participants, Mrs. Mead urged those interested to enroll as soon as possible.

Mrs. Mead has studied at the Johns Hopkins Medical School Department of Art as Applied to Medicine, the Baltimore Art Museum, and the Corcoran School of Art in Wash., D. C.

She has also completed Florida State University extension courses and is now studying with the faculty at the Fine Arts Institute. This is her third year in Sarasota.

Students may begin the class any time, enrolling at the start of any of the Tuesday sessions at the Institute studios on the New College waterfront campus.
