A special showing of the film, "A Time for Burning," will be held in the large private dining room of Hamilton Center Sunday, June 4, 1967 at 8 p.m.

The film, which shows one of the dilemmas of Christianity, has been obtained by the Rev. Horace N. Cooper, a former Army chaplain who now is assisting the dean of students office in the area of religious affairs.

"A Time for Burning" tells the story of a Lutheran pastor who attempted to integrate his Omaha church only to run into problems both within and without his church. The film was made by the Lutheran Church and is one of a series of outstanding films dealing with some of the realities of religious life.
