SARASOTA--An exhibition of 18 paintings by Sarasota artist Glenna Finch in the New College Gallery will be open to the public Monday as the second full show to be displayed in this new space.

The collection of paintings, all done within the past 18 months, represents the artist's depictions of space and color and also definite forms against space.

The show was arranged and hung by New College Curator Herbert C. Stoddard, who also created the gallery, using one of the private dining rooms in Hamilton Center on the college's East Campus. The gallery is open daily to visitors.

Mrs. Finch, a native of the Northwest area of the United States, came to Sarasota to study at the Pingling School of Art. She later studied with Hilton Leech, Syd Solomon and all of the faculty of the Fine Arts Institute. Wife of a Sarasota physician, Mrs. Finch has served as a director and exhibition chairman of the Sarasota Art Association. Her paintings have won a number of awards in Florida competition.

The show will remain in the gallery until March 23.
